RULES CHANGE - EFFECTIVE SATURDAY, 28 MARCH 1987

Effective with the next TRW Amateur Radio Club Swap Meet on Saturday, 28 March 1987, the following rule change will take place:

No one will be allowed on the TRW property before 0600 on Saturday. This includes any of the TRW roadways or parking lots. TRW Security personnel have been instructed to remove anyone from the TRW property prior to 0600.

This rule change was required by the TRW Systems Employee Association (SEA) and was made necessary due to insurance liability concerns and cost.

The Swap Meet seller's lot opens at 0700, and the event is over at 1130. Vehicles, both buyers and sellers, will be allowed to enter the TRW property at 0600 - no earlier. Sellers can start to line up at the entrance to the seller's lot at that time.

It is strongly suggested that no one come to the Swap Meet area before 0600 so that we do not run the risk of being shut down by the City of Manhattan Beach due to neighborhood complaints about cars lining up during the night in front of their homes. Continued success can only be assured by strict adherence to the rules of TRW Inc., the City of Manhattan Beach, and the TRW Amateur Radio Club.
